- **4 45K UPC's Recognized by Matrix**
- **4** 20K UPC's Unidentified
- **4** 1,160 UPC'S Undercharged Tax
- **4** 2,381 UPC'S Overcharged Tax
- **4** Net Tax Significance \$109,000
- Manual Review Tax Significance \$6,000
